

**THE “STRAIGHT A’S IN LIFE” SCHOLARSHIP
SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL OF LIFE FOUNDATION**

The “**Straight A’s In Life**” Scholarship will be awarded annually to High School Seniors from the Washington County School District who have completed the *Learn to “School” Your toughest Opponent* 4 week session (per 1 quarter) at their high school; attended the high school for at least one year, and will be seeking higher education after graduating from high school. One Senior will be selected from each participating high school as determined by the School of Life Foundation.

Strong consideration given for the candidates’ academic performance, financial need, & completion of a project from one of the “A’s” of *Learn to “School” Your Toughest Opponent*” workbook and applying the “Straight A’s In Life” which are:

**APPRECIATION, ASSIST, ATTITUDE, AIM, ASSOCIATE
ALIGN, ACTION, AVOID, ADAPT, ALWAYS!**

The “Straight A’s In Life” Scholarship dollar value is \$500.00 per high school
The applicant will be selected without regard to race, religion or cultural background.

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CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- 1) Academic Performance: The Candidate should have demonstrated a strong work ethic in academics with improvement occurring after completing the School of Life training; a 2.5 Grade point average or above is suggested.
- 2) Financial Need: To be determined from personal information included with the application to the Scholarship Committee; the candidate’s economic status can possibly be determined from information provided through the High School’s counseling department.
- 3) Eligibility – Senior attending at least one year in any Washington County High School participating in the School of Life Program. Counselor must verify completion of the program.
- 4) Applicant is to describe in a one page essay a completed project on one of the A’s which would have been an influence or an added strength and how it will possibly affect their future (Pictures or video footage can be included)
- 5) Candidates for the “Straight A’s in Life” Scholarship can receive direction through their High School Counselor, i.e. Counseling Center to properly complete the application. If questions or concerns arise, the High School Counselor will contact the SOLF Scholarship Committee. Please submit the completed application within 2 weeks after your completing of the coursework at your school.
- 6) Application to include: Cover sheet with photo, name, parents name, address, phone, high school & possible institutions of higher education which have been applied to at the time. This is added to the above required information.
- 7) Applications will be reviewed by the School of Life Foundation Scholarship Committee with recommendation then made to the SOLF Board of Directors.
- 8) The “Straight A’s In Life” Scholarship must be used within 3 years of being awarded. The WCSD will hold the Scholarship based on the student’s needs OR the Scholarship can be put in a trust at a Financial Institution for the student made payable to the school of choice in the student’s name.
